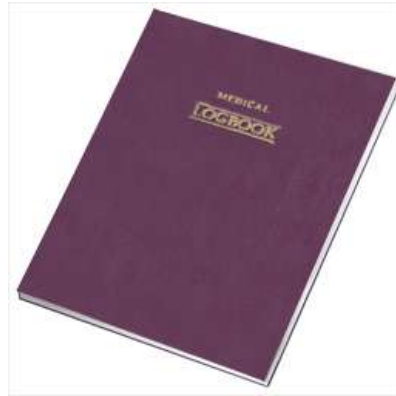


Instructions in maintaining the log book



The log book reflects the skills that you are acquired during **6** days of your skills programme.

You have to sign your log book when you performed a procedure and it is essential to perform all essential skills during this 5 day programme.

In page number 02 you have to fill your personal details as well as the names of the consultant anaesthetist and the consultant physician.

Filling of the pages 2, 3 and 4 are mandatory to obtain your skills certificate. At the same time you should carry out at least 80% of Essential skills and a minimum of 6 pages of the portfolio to obtain the skills certificate.

Portfolio written should be counter signed by a consultant or MOIC/MO (if any case the consultant is not available while doing the procedure) in that unit.

When you maintain the log book you will acquire the skill of portfolio writing too.
